Previous Minutes:

Minutes of previous AGM held 13th November 2016 – Voted as true and correct by those present.

Chairman's report - Jim Turner:

Jim welcomed everyone and thanked the members for the high number attending.

Jim provided a brief report on the happenings of 2017 the 22nd year of the Fatboys.

Waterbird productions released their Mamil movie which featured the Fatboys on several occasions.

There was a large focus on safety this year after a high number of accidents in recent years. A new safety committee was formed to analyse cycling accidents within the club and make recommendations to help reduce the chances of injury.

Jim reminded members that they are all getting older and to be careful on the roads!

Jim closed by thanking all those who have contributed to the running of the club and reminded members to nurture their friendships within the club.

Finances - Bill Dartnell:

Current total monies in bank stands at \$14,000 a profit of \$3,666 for the year. Most of this profit was from a \$3,300 bonus paid by Tinelli from the purchase of the new Fatboys uniform.

The Willunga Hill Tour Down Under BBQ and the Hawaiian shirt ride raised \$4,000 donated to the Adelaide Day Centre.

Uniform:

Rides Report - Matt Ferris:

While Matt Ferris remains the nominated ride coordinator, several members have set up special interest rides.

Rob Lang organizes a once a month "Mountain Bike Cruisers" ride.

Errol Weber organizes a once a month "Hills Cruisers" ride.

There is "Brooxy"s Outer Harbour Rebels" rides and Saturday morning "Comfort Cruisers" rides.

Details are usually provided via the Fatboy's "Viber groups" and now via a new phone app called Team App which provides a calendar with extended ride details and a provision for registering for the ride.

Groups participating in single ride events requiring long distant travel and/or accommodation are also often organized by a Fatboy member(s) i.e. Amy's Grand Fondue, Alpine Classic, etc.

Membership - Errol Weber:

Current active member numbers went up from 84 to 87 this year. Average age is 56 years 10 months. There are 9 Michael's, 5 Richard's and 5 David's. Most membership renewals will be due in December and members are encourage to attend to their membership renewals ASAP.

A few members managed to get a discount with an early payment (with some difficulty), this opportunity has now lapsed.

Safety – Jack Frost:

The safety committee carried out a detailed survey of cycling accidents within the Fatboy's community. Details are available on the website. The following main recommendations were made:

Members to know the 10 riding commandments as listed on the website.

Mentor to look after new members and provide them with direction on how to ride within a the Fatboy peloton.

Members need to communicate up and down the peloton line and be willing to chastise riders doing the wrong thing.

A vote of thanks to Jack and all the safety committee for their effort and the results they provided.

Christmas Function – Rob Bramley:

The 2017 Christmas Party is set for Saturday 16th December, at the Norwood Hotel – refer the emails from Rob.
